

## A Word From Pastor Susan


*"There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under the heavens" (Ecclesiastes 3:1).*

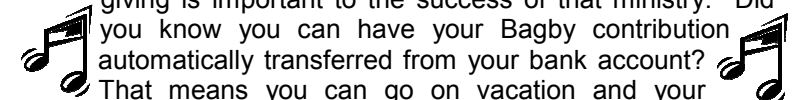
